

## **Announcing the Event**

Domestic fish catches continue to decline due to declining fish stocks and changes in the marine environment: according to the 2023 edition of the Fisheries White Paper, the production value of the fishing and aquaculture industry in 2010 was 1,600.1 billion yen, almost halved since its peak in 1982. This makes it difficult to secure stable fish catches.

Meanwhile, there are concerns that the balance between supply and demand for protein will be disrupted as the population increases and economic development progresses, particularly in emerging economies. As a solution to this problem, 'land-based aquaculture' is attracting attention: according to an FAO report, aquaculture production in 2022 will exceed capture fisheries for the first time, and further market expansion is expected.

Land-based aquaculture is less affected by the natural environment and allows for planned production. It also has a low environmental impact and is attracting attention from the perspectives of health-consciousness and ecosystem protection, especially with the increasing demand for salmon.

Against this backdrop, the Aquaponics & Land-Based Aquaculture Equipment Exhibition, which was first held last year, has been relaunched as the Land-Based Aquaculture Equipment Exhibition, specialising in equipment for Land-Based aquaculture, and will be held for the second time this October. The exhibition will bring together advanced equipment and technologies aimed at building an efficient and environmentally friendly aquaculture model. It aims to be a place where industry, local authorities and research institutions can work together to support the development of a sustainable aquaculture industry.
