

1. Exhibit Space Fee JPY 429,000 per booth

1 Unit Booth - 9sqm. (3m(w)×3m(d))
(10% Japanese consumption tax is included)
Please note that bank Charge (JPY 10,000) is going to be charged for each bank remittance.

2. Corner booth reservation JPY 110,000 (tax included)

When you're applying for exhibition space, the corner booths can be reserved for an additional fee.

- The abovementioned fee applies regardless of the number of booths.
- If an application is made for 4 or more booths, then in principle, at least one corner booth will be allocated without the additional fee.
- If the type of booth is not specified in the application form, arrangements will be made based on the number of booths, order of application, etc.

5. Withholding or Rejection of Application

In case the management office judges the exhibit inappropriate for this exhibition, the management office may consider the application as invalid.

6. Payment of Exhibit Space Fee

After the approval of the contents of the application form, the management office will send you an invoice. Please fulfill the payment of your exhibit space fee by **June 30, Mon., 2025.**

*Japanese yen cash remittance only.

*Bank charges must be paid by applicants. Chargeable JPY 10,000 for each bank remittance.

7. Cancellation

Once an application is accepted, no withdrawal is allowed as a general rule. If the management office consider our judgement as appropriate, however, application may be withdrawn with payment of prescribed cancellation charge.

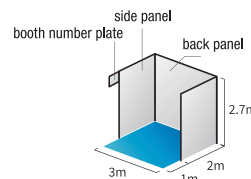
8. Basic Booth

*Carpet will not be provided for booths. (option item)

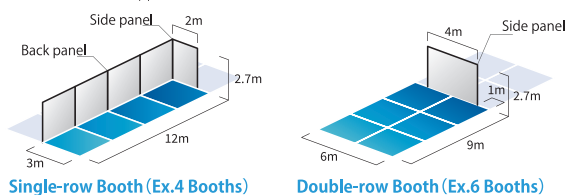
*Panels will not be provided for Island booths.

9. Booth Type are available

Available three types of booth (Refer to application form):
- Single-row booths, double-row-booths, (applicable for 4 booths or more),
Island booths (applicable for 12 booths or more (scheduled))



10. Booth Allotment

The management office decides booth allocation taking into consideration the exhibits, number of booths and demonstration plans, etc.

11. Not Included in the Exhibit Fee:

- Booth decoration and operation expenses.
- Installation and usage of electricity and utilities.
- Damage insurance for the exhibits, etc.
- Expense for injuries arising during exhibition or while transporting equipment.
- Renovating exhibits and decorations, etc., required by regulations and exhibition rules.
- Other expenses not included in the basic booth.

12. Other Rules

Other details and regulations will be explained in the Exhibitor's Manual will be sent to applicants who already applied.

13. Alteration and Cancellation of the Show

The management office reserve the right to postpone indefinitely or cancel the show if the exhibition has become unable to be opened on account of force majeure (earthquakes, disasters, war, terrorism, epidemics diseases or infectious diseases, other disturbances, etc.) In these cases, the management office will refund the exhibit fee based on the following rate. If the applicant has not paid the fee at the time of alteration or cancellation, the applicant pay the difference between the exhibit space fee and the refund will amount based on the following rate.

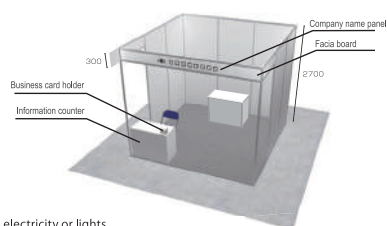

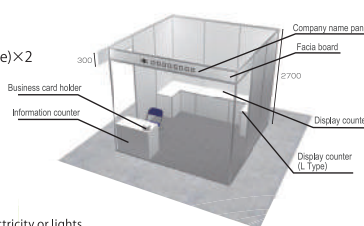

Announcing the Event

Domestic fish catches continue to decline due to declining fish stocks and changes in the marine environment: according to the 2023 edition of the Fisheries White Paper, the production value of the fishing and aquaculture industry in 2010 was 1,600.1 billion yen, almost halved since its peak in 1982. This makes it difficult to secure stable fish catches.

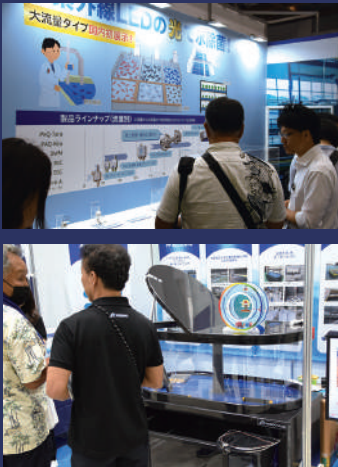
Meanwhile, there are concerns that the balance between supply and demand for protein will be disrupted as the population increases and economic development progresses, particularly in emerging economies. As a solution to this problem, 'land-based aquaculture' is attracting attention: according to an FAO report, aquaculture production in 2022 will exceed capture fisheries for the first time, and further market expansion is expected.

Land-based aquaculture is less affected by the natural environment and allows for planned production. It also has a low environmental impact and is attracting attention from the perspectives of health-consciousness and ecosystem protection, especially with the increasing demand for salmon.

Against this backdrop, the Aquaponics & Land-Based Aquaculture Equipment Exhibition, which was first held last year, has been relaunched as the Land-Based Aquaculture Equipment Exhibition, specialising in equipment for Land-Based aquaculture, and will be held for the second time this October. The exhibition will bring together advanced equipment and technologies aimed at building an efficient and environmentally friendly aquaculture model. It aims to be a place where industry, local authorities and research institutions can work together to support the development of a sustainable aquaculture industry.

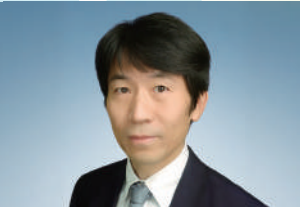

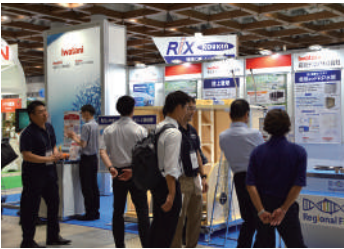
